ALL SOULS PARISH 2023 FURNACE FUND

We are proud to warm the more than 800 souls in our parish community by keeping the flame of faith burning. But we need to keep our bodies warm (and cool!) as well.

The HVAC system in the church was installed when it was built in 1997. The furnace and a/c unit servicing the west side of the church has failed and is obsolete. We must replace the west

unit entirely in order to keep our congregation comfy year-round.

Replacement Cost: \$40,000

Installation: \$10,000



The former school building will soon become a source of rental revenue and houses our 140+ Religious Education students. We have been advised to maintain the current boiler with the following necessary updates.



Burner Unit for Boiler: \$21,000 Replacement Vacuum Unit: \$9,000

Installation: \$20,000

TOTAL OF REPAIRS & REPLACEMENTS: \$100,000
